## Cyber Security & Street Smart on Drugs

### Course Description.

**Safety First! Cyber and Information Security for your Everyday Life.** This Ohio Homeland Security presentation will provide attendees with an overview of the Strategic Analysis & Information Center, its mission, and its role in both the state and national homeland security stages. The discussion will then focus on cybersecurity and will present an overview of today's common threat actors, and their methods and motives. Jurisdictional issues will be explained as they relate to cyber events and methods of reporting.

**Street Smart on Drugs.** The criminal justice system is inundated by individuals and crimes that have ties to narcotics use or trafficking. This course will provide court reporters with current and up-to-date information on narcotics trends, terminology, paraphernalia, and the physiological effects of narcotic use. The course is designed to increase awareness of terms related to substance abuse.

Participants will learn the significance of the terms probationers are using, terms like "Molly," "Skittling," "Bagging," "Pharming" and "Flipping." In addition, participants will learn the street names for common drugs, their methods of distribution, prices, and new ways drugs are being ingested.

This course will also provide participants the opportunity to see actual designer street drugs, such as XTC, K2, Bath Salts, LSD, GHB, Liquaweed, and BHO. Current drug paraphernalia used in camouflaging drug use will also be available to be seen. Drugs covered will be Rave drugs, "Date Rape" Drugs, Hallucinogens, and inhalants. So-called "traditional" drugs such as marijuana, cocaine, crack, heroin, and methamphetamine are also covered extensively. A portion of the program deals with prescription medications, because of their easy accessibility in most households and dramatic rise in abuse in Ohio.
